

THERE'S MORE TO A SHOWER TRAY THAN YOU MIGHT THINK!

Some of the biggest problems that can occur with a shower tray are **cracking**, **discolouration and the loss of surface lustre**. This is not a particularly uncommon occurrence with '**gel-coat**' trays.

In the event of a shower tray cracking, it is not simply a case of replacing the faulty unit. In order to remove and reinstall a new tray it will also require the removal and reinstallation of the shower door.

Whilst these costs of replacing a faulty tray are building up, it doesn't stop there. If your shower area is tiled, then some of these tiles around the tray will also need to be removed, and possibly broken off. If this is the case you will need to source the same type of tiles that you had originally fitted.

This is where the real problems can occur. Quite often, you will not be able to find the exact same type of tile. Even if you do, the batch numbers are likely to be different, causing unsightly variations in shade to the original tiles. If you are unable to find a perfect match, then you are left in the unenviable position of either having a mismatch of tiles or going to the considerable expense of retiling the entire shower area!

Thankfully, you can limit your exposure to such risk by ensuring that you **only** install a quality shower tray by **Spa-Jet**.

So, what are the types of shower tray found on the market? Below is a list of some of the most common types available -

- Acrylic Capped ABS, resin-bonded stone.
- Gel-coat, resin bonded stone.
- High density foam polymer.
- Fibre glass

So, which of these should you choose? We say 'Acrylic Capped ABS, resin-bonded stone'! This is because, like for like, none of the others are comparable in strength to this type of shower tray, manufactured by SPA-JET. Tests have shown that Acrylic Capped ABS shower trays are up to 400% stronger and more resistant to cracking than ALL of the others.

This great enhancement in strength of the shower tray is due to the combination of the 'high impact ABS' material reinforced with 'Structural Resin Bonded Stone'. This makes the tray extremely resistant to cracking under normal use.

In addition, the **Spa-Jet** shower tray has an Acrylic surface finish. This provides a hard, durable and long lasting sheen that is not prone to the discolouration that gel-coat trays are. Acrylic is also the same surface material that is commonly found on most bathtubs. This means that a Spa-Jet tray may share the same colour and reflective properties adding to the uniformity of your bathroom. Spa-Jet believes in backing up their claims by confidently offering a **25 year manufacturers guarantee*** so that you can have peace of mind.

You may now be thinking, 'what extra is this going to cost me?' Fortunately, in many cases, the **Spa-Jet** shower tray will retail at much the **same price** as the inferior types. However, some showrooms will still provide the inferior types of tray, in particular the 'gel-coat resin bonded' models, unless **you** specify differently.
